There is an expectation that you have arranged with your employer that you can attend some weekday callouts. Please have this discussion before applying to join us.

## UNCERTAINTY

In addition to the uncertainty that surrounds when a call out might come there can also be uncertainty about:

SEARCH

If the search will happen at all, happily, missing people do get found after we have been call upon but before we are deployed in the field

before we are deployed in the field the length of time the search will go on for that day

How many days the search might stretch over.

The IMT and your field team leader always have team members safety in mind, breaks and rest periods are part of the search process.
